Board Report October 18, 2019

The board of education met in regular session last night in the district offices.

Administrative Reports

The Teacher Minute featured Cedar Ridge Elementary and highlighted the practices associated with Behavior Intervention. Presenters included Jonathan Beasley, Nancy Brashers and Melissa Halbrook. Student council representatives provided an overview of building activities. Dr. Swofford submitted reports on the following: September enrollment is 4,831 (last year's count was 4,838); an update on DESE activities; a community meeting scheduled October 22 to provide district information to our elected officials; and announced staff/student recognitions which include Jamey Derks who has been named the KRZK/Central Bank Teacher of the Month for October; Nathan Vijitbenjaronk who will be honored by Johns Hopkins University through the Center for Talented Youth program and Adrian Johnson was a recent presenter at the Missouri Arts Conference.
