## Board Report April 14, 2017

The board of education met in regular session last night in the district offices. The report of the annual school election was presented by Kim Bryant, board secretary. Craig Wescott, Angie Smith and Jeff Smethers were elected to serve three-year terms. The oath of office was issued by Bryant. Board elections followed. Peter Marcellus was elected president; Roger Frieze was elected Vice President; Kim Bryant was elected secretary; and Don Forrest was elected treasurer.

## Administrative Reports
