## Board Report February 23, 2018

The board of education met in regular session last night in the district offices.

## **Administrative Reports**

The *Teacher Minute* was provided by staff from Cedar Ridge Primary and focused on the Motor Lab that is in use. Student council representatives provided an overview of activities in the Junior High and High School. Dr. Swofford presented information to the board on the following topics: the January student membership count is 4,785 (up from the January 2017 count of 4,749); the last day of school – to date – is May 21; legislative updates; an overview of the national superintendent's conference held earlier this month; and Branson hosted a two-day workshop on the *Artisan Leader* led by Mike Rutherford (representatives from southwest Missouri schools were in attendance). Dr. Swofford announced *Good News* about the following: **CRE students** collected food for CAM through a recent drive; BI teachers **McQueen**, **Jenkins** and **Bradley** presented at the *Write to Learn* conference; dancers **Harris**, **Townsend** and **Arnette** helped raise over \$9,000 for Project Graduation; and two Junior High art students, **Maryjane Linn** and **Kaden Justus**, have been selected to have their artwork on display in Missouri's capitol. Mr. Watson presented the annual transportation ridership report. Dr. Collins announced that Cedar Ridge Elementary students collected \$698.18 for the Leukemia/Lymphoma Society. Dr. Brenner provided information on the success of the district's Twitter Chat held last week.
