Board Report March 24, 2017

The board of education met in regular session last night in the district offices. Teresa Givens was honored for her 12 years of service to the board of education and presented a plaque.

Administrative Reports

The Teacher Minute was presented by kindergarten students and staff from Cedar Ridge Primary. The presentation focused on the benefits of spending time in the gym before school each day. Student council representatives provided an overview of activities in the Junior High and High School. Dr. Swofford provided information to the board on the following items: legislative items affecting school districts; an overview of the national conference he attended for school administrators; a recap of the high school musical *Peter Pan*; and an overview of the high school job fair. He also informed the board that 29 High School vocal music students received a "T" rating at districts and will advance to state competition; the DECA students will advance to the International Contest; the BHS jazz musicians performed at districts; Lisa Phillips was named the Southwest Missouri Counselor of the Year; Jenn Thomas was named the KRZK/Central Bank Teacher of the Month; and he talked about the success of the Lady Pirate basketball team. Dr. Forrest provided an update on the completion of the seating addition at the baseball field. Mrs. Bryant reviewed the April 4 official election ballot. Mr. Watson reported that the annual bus fleet inspection, conducted by the Missouri State Highway Patrol on March 6 and 7, earned a 100% safety rating. There were 65 buses inspected.
