What:	\$1000 College Scholarship (renewable up to 4 years)
Who Can Apply:	Any Taney County high school senior whose life has been affected by cancer (either directly or indirectly) attending an accredited two or four year institution as a full time student.
Requirements:	Applicant must complete all essay questions and turn in a completed application online, and agree to a press release if they are selected as the scholarship recipient.
Application Deadline:	Applications must be submitted on or before March 31st. Applications will be scored by a committee and two winners will be chosen, submitted for board approval, and then notified in May before graduation. A check will then be written to the institution the student is attending.

- How has cancer affected your life, and what have you learned from it? Include details explaining the impact it made on your family, community, and personal experience.
