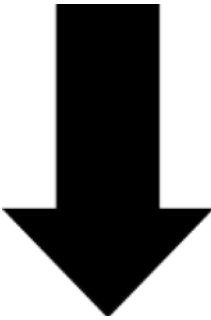

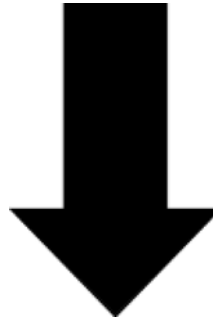

Building Specific Action Plans

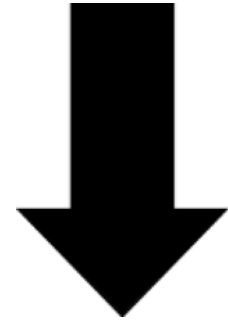
1. All classroom teachers will participate in Tier 1 Attendance Intervention supports in an effort to provide consistent academic interventions.
2. Teachers will utilize the district created curriculum as they integrate content in a cross curricular method of delivery.
3. CRE faculty will participate in instructional focused collaboration that will identify instructional shifts necessary for student growth.



Instruction

Building Specific Action Plans

1. Teachers will provide prescriptive small group interventions to support sequential skill development in core areas. (writing, vocabulary, and informational text)
2. Interventionists will administer the Word Pattern Survey assessment to differentiate Literacy instruction.
3. Teachers and administrators will work in partnership to chart student growth in academic areas of need identified as grade level/ team goals in individual, Professional Growth Plans.



Accountability

Building Specific Action Plans

1. Students will reach and maintain 91% APR as a result of Attendance Intervention supports.
2. Targeted grade level, ELA interventions and an instructional focus will yield one RIT band advancement, for identified students, on the NWEA Spring assessment.
3. Students receiving Literacy intervention will advance one proficiency level on the Spring Word Pattern Survey assessment.
4. PBIS data will reflect a 10 percent decrease in discipline referrals as a result of student engagement incentives.

INNOVATION & SUPPORT

1. **Student Lens Approach-** CRE faculty and staff will facilitate a student lens approach to school engagement with PBIS and attendance incentives. (Game Days, Pirate Pals, Hallway Greeters, Student Mentoring, etc.)
2. **Math Night-** Students led math activities, games and rotations to demonstrate their knowledge of enVision 2.0 curriculum components. Parents attended a short information meeting to provide resources to help connect school and home.
3. **Showcase Night-** CRE will host a showcase event to highlight student growth in Pirate High Five skills. (Greetings, Manners, Conversation, Empathy, and Grit).
