Great Food and a Great Value!

- Breakfast for pre-K – 6th graders is only \$1.00 and \$1.25 for Jr & High School Students.
- Primary and Elementary lunches are \$1.95
- Intermediate lunches are \$2.05
- Jr High lunches are \$2.25
- High School lunches are \$2.35
- Students who qualify for reduced-price meals pay \$0.30 for breakfast and \$0.40 for lunch.
- Students may also qualify for FREE meals!
- Adults & Visiting Children pay \$1.50 for breakfast and \$3.25 for lunch.

How do you apply for free and reduced-price meals?

- **A new Free and Reduced-Price Family Meal Application must be completed each year.**
- Applications are mailed to all households each summer, you can pick up an application at any school building, or print it from the District website.
- Provide all required information and sign the application so we can quickly process it.
- Allow 10 days to process the application.
 - Once your application is processed, you will receive either an email or letter stating your status. You can also call the Food Service Office.
- For the first 30 days of school, if you had children receiving free or reduced meals last year, your pre-school or kindergartner may be eligible for those benefits too; while your new application is being processed. Please request and complete a **Kindergarten Sibling Form** and return it to any school office.

We invite you to join your child for breakfast or lunch in the cafeteria. Check with your school's office for procedures. We feel that once you experience the quality and variety of healthy choices we offer, you will better appreciate the time-savings and value that school meals offers.

Manage Your Child's Meals

Our School Nutrition Program is self-supporting and receives no local tax dollars. The financial health of our program depends on parents keeping accounts up to date. We require parents to pre-pay to ensure their child's account always has funds to cover meals. You can pre-pay by the week, by the month, or for the entire year.

How do you make a payment on your child's account?

- You can access the **Parent Portal** through the Branson Schools Website and make payments directly to your child's account via Pay Pal.
- If you send a check, please write your child's full name in the memo area of the check and secure it in an envelope marked lunch money.
- If you must send cash, place it in a sealed envelope and write your child's full name, teacher, the amount of cash, and lunch money on the front of the envelope.
- If you are sending money in for more than one child, include the information for each child.
